

TIMBERLINE CAMP On June 11.

1936, ground was broken for the Timberline Lodge in Northwest Oregon. Built entirely by hand, inside and out, the building is a tribute to the skills and spirit of a nation. The Timberline Camp by MossCreek employs the same hand-made spirit that the crafts people of the 30's utilized, a spirit which captured the uniqueness of a time where skill was the greatest attribute. This design includes 3 bedrooms, 2 1/2 baths, with a master bedroom on the main level. A large story-and-a-half vaulted Great Room with exposed log trusses and an open Kitchen/Dining room complete a dramatic interior. Exterior log detailing complements the feel of this Pacific Northwest Camp.
